# The Wearing of the American Legion Cap, Uniform and Regalia

Female members of the American Legion should wear their caps in the manner prescribed for female personnel of the armed forces.

Legionnaires wishing to attach decorations and other official insignia to their caps:

- a. Consecutive membership insignia, membership stars and/or decorations (authorized American Legion or military services) must be attached to the right side of the cap. Fraternal or civil organization insignia cannot be used on American Legion caps.
- b. Names or nicknames of individual members cannot be used on caps.
